

Taminmin College dress code

Taminmin College requires all students to wear the approved school uniform while attending school and participating in official school activities. Wearing a uniform promotes a positive school identity and supports a safe, inclusive learning environment.

Compulsory Uniform Items

Students must wear the following items as part of the Taminmin College uniform:

- **Middle School Shirts:** Maroon, black and white shirt with the college logo - \$ 32.00
- **Senior School Shirts:** Maroon, black and white shirt with the college logo - \$32.00
- **Bottoms:**
 - Black AFL shorts or sports shorts with the college logo - \$20.00
 - Plain black shorts or skorts (no logos or coloured panels)
- **Footwear:** Enclosed shoes

Support measures are available to assist families with uniform purchases.

Optional Uniform Items:

The following items may be worn with the school uniform:

- A hat
- A jumper of any colour
- Sports team coloured shirts on designated school sports days

Support for families:

The Back-to-School payment scheme provides each student with a \$200 voucher to support parents to pay for certain school related costs, including school uniforms. This voucher must be used by the end of Term 3 in each school year.

Taminmin College provides additional support to ensure all students can access the required uniform. Support measures may include:

- Second-hand uniforms at reduced prices
- Payment plans for new uniform items
- Assistance for families experiencing financial hardship

Unacceptable dress code:

The following items are not permitted:

- Open shoes, thongs, slides, crocs or birkenstocks
- Tights, leggings or bike shorts
- Uniform items that are untidy or dirty
- Shorts with logos, brand names or coloured panels.

Non-Compliance

If a student attend school out of uniform:

- Parents or carers will be contacted to supply appropriate clothing
- Support options will be discussed if needed
- Students may be provided with a loan item where available
